

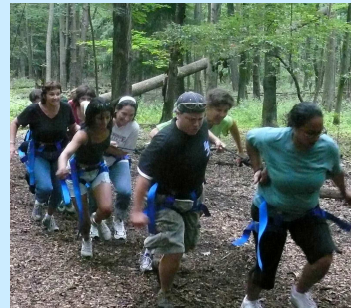

By the end of the day our hope is that each participant will have extracted new knowledge and skills that will be applicable in your office.

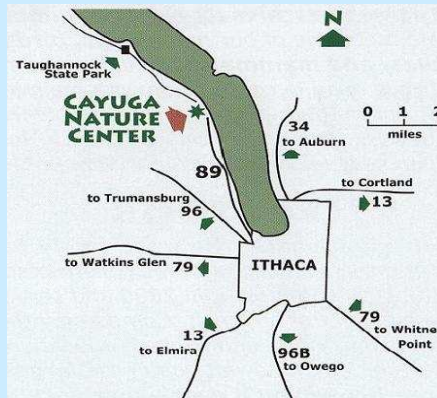
TEAM Challenge Program

On Site at Cayuga Nature Center

- Adults: \$10.00 per person per hour
